Understanding the Personal Health Information Act: Considerations for Evaluation

Content: The Government of Newfoundland and Labrador has passed the Personal Health Information Act, which is new health-sector-specific privacy legislation that addresses the protection of individuals' personal health information. This presentation will review some of the key aspects of the legislation and provide an overview of what sorts of changes persons working in the health and community services sector can expect.

Target Audience: This session will be of value to program managers, staff or private consultants involved in planning and carrying out research and evaluation related activity related to this sector.
